**RESTRICTIONS:** Generally the South Side Conservation District does not make grants for annual operating expenses, to purchase tickets for events, fund individuals, or support fundraising projects. The District will not make a grant to organizations which, in policy or practice, unfairly discriminate by sex, race, national origin, or creed. The District requires a 25% sponsor match for the grant. (Example of matching source: School, service organization, business or other grants. Can be dollar amount or in-kind services)
